The organisation is a local East-Timorese managed NGO that was established in 2000 in response to the growing awareness of the inequalities experienced by persons with disabilities in East Timor.

KATILOSA works from a human rights perspective, working with and for persons with disabilities to promote and protect the Human Rights of persons with disabilities in East Timor.

KATILOSA focuses primary attention on children and young people, as early detection, intervention and education can reduce the impact of disability on the individual, family and community.

KATILOSA is committed to improving the outcomes for persons with disabilities through providing concrete programs and activities that follow a CBR approach to disability.

## Baucau Rehabilitation & Training Centre, Darasula

CBR is a holistic approach to working with persons with disabilities that is implemented through the combined efforts of people with disabilities, their families, other organizations, communities and relevant government sectors. KATILOSA uses the CBR Matrix as the basis of program design with an emphasis on primary areas of health, education, livelihoods, social inclusion and empowerment.
